

D2 – RESIDENCE VISA FOR THE EXERCISE OF AN INDEPENDENT PROFESSIONAL OR DIRECTED TO IMMIGRANTS ENTREPRENEURS

1.	Application Form	Completely filled and signed by the applicant.		
2.	Valid Passport	Passport valid for an additional 3 months following the duration of the intended stay		
3.	Passport Photographs	Two identical passport photographs, up-to-date and in good condition, allowing proper identification		
4.	Travel Reservation	Travel reservation ensuring the return of the applicant to the home country.		
5.	Travel Insurance	Valid travel insurance covering necessary medical expenses, including emergency assistance and repatriation.		
6.	SEF	Form authorizing access to Portuguese criminal record consultation by the Immigration and Border Services (Serviço de Estrangeiros e Fronteiras – SEF).		
7.	PCC (police Clearance certificate)	Police Clearance certificate from the applicant's country of origin or country of residence for over one year – the Police Clearance certificate is only considered valid up to three months after the date of issuance. Older PCC's will not be accepted.		
8.	Proof Of Accommodations	Hotel reservation/apartment confirmation.		
9.	Substance Proof, (bank & income)	Proof of means of subsistence, which may be produced through a term of responsibility issued by the worker hosting entity or company.		
10.	DOCS REQ. FOR THE PRACTISE OF AN INDEPENDENT PROFESSIONAL ACTIVITY	Work contract as an independent service provider, Proof of relevant academic qualifications or professional experience in the work contract's related field. Proof that the applicant is qualified to practice the profession, when such a profession is regulated in Portugal.		
11.	DOCS REQ. FROM IMMIGRANTS ENTREPRENEURS OR FOR START -UP VISAS	Document proving the applicant's previous investments operations or the possession of the financial means in Portugal needed to proceed to an operation of such nature. Or A document proving the applicant's possession of financial means in Portugal, including the ones obtained in a financial institution in Portuguese territory, and the intention to proceed to an investment operation in Portugal – details of the investment must be given. Or A declaration issued by IAPMEI (Agência para a Competitividade e Inovação, I.P.), certifying the signing agreement of an incubation contract with a certified incubator, in accordance with Article 6o of Normative Order n.º 4/2018 of the Minister of Economy, of 2 February that regulates the Start-up Visa Programs.		

Note: (1) Applicant could be asked for additional documents or may be called for an Interview if desired by The Embassy of Portugal, New Delhi. (2) Carry all documents in Original at the time of interview. (3) National Visas require consultation of one or more authorities in Portugal, therefore the Embassy and those authorities require at least 30 working days after the visa is submitted or after the interview (if the same is requested by the Embassy) to process the visa application.
